The new structure is made up of two major parts, the invitation documents and the contractual frameworks. Maintaining the separation of these components removes impediments caused by a restrictive set of templates. In this model, the invitation documents aren't tied to any contract, so you can mix and match the components to build a procurement process and contract framework that suits the characteristics of the requirement.

Simple process, simple contract, simple process strong contract, complex process simple contract, etc. They are even designed to allow the use of non-standard contracts. This model provides a great deal of flexibility for the buyers to tailor their process and contracts as required.

In changing this structure, they also broke the Definitions and Interpretations document out into a separate standalone document. This fixes the irritating inconsistency of terminology and definitions between contract frameworks in the previous model. One definition applies to all invitation and contract documents
